

## Lesson 3

Start the TextWrangler program.

Open the "index.html" file that you have in your folder from Lesson 2.

The <body> content of the file should look something like what follows:

We want to add three things to this file which will establish distinct sections on our page.

Save the file and view it in your browser.

When displayed in your browser the page should look something like the picture below.

The changes begin to add structure to our design by breaking the page up into several sections.



Now we want to give your mark-up some of the same structural meaning that was evident by viewing the file in your browser.

To do that, we will employ the use of the `<div>` or division element.

Each `<div>` element will have attribute in the form of an id which easily identifies which part of the page it is.

Let's take a look at how we would make a division out of your Header for example:  
(extra spacing added for clarity)
